STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

- 455-460 Clay, as 435-440 above, rare orange mineral.
- 460-465 Clay, medium grey, orange minor light fawn stringers, rare carbonaceous-wood fragments, rare red rounded quartz pebbles, finely textured, moderately compacted.
- 465-470. Clay, medium grey, minor orange, rare carbonaceous-wood fragments, medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 470-475 Clay, as 465-470 above.
- 475-480 Clay, medium and light grey, stringers, scattered carbonaceous-wood fragments, scattered reddish brown sideritic clay fragments, rare limonitic stained magnetitic shale fragments, rare angular quartzite fragments, medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 480-485 Clay, as 475-480 above.
- 485-490 Clay, as 475-480 above, scattered orange clay.
- 490-495 Clay, medium grey, rare orange inclusions, rare carbonaceous streaks, rare reddish brown sideritic clay inclusions, rare mica, finely to medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 495-500 Clay, as 490-495 above, scattered carbonaceous-wood fragments,
- 500-510 Clay, as 490-495 above, except some orange and white clay inclusions.
- 510-520 Clay, medium to dark grey, scattered white, yellow and orange stringers, rare carbonaceous-wood fragments, finely textured, moderately compacted.
