## STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

- 0-5 Silt, light to medium brown, rare mica, finely textured, moderately compacted.
- 5-10 Sandy Clay, medium orange brown, common medium sorted to very coarse grained of clear, white, smokey grey quartz and quartzite set in silty clay matrix, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 10-15 Pebble Sand, clear, light brown, smokey grey, white, fine to very coarsely grained to pebble up to 1/8" diameter, sub-angular, poorly sorted, quartz and quartzite, some dolerite, dirty, common light brown and orange silty and finely grained sandy interstitial material, moderately compacted, occasional reddish brown ferruginous staining, loosely compacted.
- 15-20 Pebble Gravel, as 10-15 above, except pebbles up to 1" in diameter, occasional pebble shows pitting and black staining.
- 20-25 Pebble Gravel, as 10-15 above, but mainly composed of quartzite pebbles.
- 25-30 Pebble Gravel, as 20-25 above.
- 30-35 Pebble Gravel, as 20-25 above.
- 35-40 Clay, medium to dark greyish brown, very finely divided, white clay specks and very finely divided carbonaceous specks, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 40-45 Clay, as 35-40 above, rare finely divided mica.
- 45-50 Clay, as 35-40 above, common pebbles of white and grey quartzite up to 1/2" diameter.
- 50-55 Clay, as 35-40 above.
- 55-60 Clay, as 35-40 above, scattered rounded pebbles of light brown to pink quartz.
- 60-65 Clay, as 35-40 above.
- 65-70 Clay, as 35-40 above, becoming silty.
- 70-75 Clay, as 65-70 above.
- 75-80 Clay, medium to dark brown, scattered to rare finely divided mica, medium to coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 80-85 Clay, as 75-80 above.
- 85-90 Clay, as 75-80 above.
- 90-95 Clay, as 75-80 above.
- 95-100 Clay, as 75-80 above.
- 100-105 Clay, as 75-80 above.
- 105-110 Clay, as 75-80 above.
- 110-115 Clay, as 75-80 above.
- 115-120 Clay, as 75-80 above.
- 120-125 Clay, as 75-80 above, rare medium grained clear quartz.
