## STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION.

- 375-380 Clayey Gravel, as 350-355 above, scattered light to white grey clay patches.
- 380-385 Clayey Gravel, as 350-355 above, scattered orange-brown silt lenses, scattered carbonaceous matter and wood fragments.
- 385-390 Clay, medium brown, common pebbles of quartz and quartzite, igneous rock? rare ferruginous shale plates, scattered reddish, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, coarsely textured, moderately compacted, brown sideritic fragments.
- 390-395 Clay, as 385-390 above.
- 395-400 Clay, as 385-390 above, but pebbles less common.
- 400-405 Clay, as 395-400 above, except scattered patches of light orange brown clay.
- 405-410 Clay, as 395-400 above.
- 410-415 Clay, as 395-400 above, scattered light brown and grey silt stringers.
- 415-420 Clay, medium brown and grey, scattered orange-brown, scattered angular fragments of quartz, quartzite, igneous rock, and some volcanic rock showing felspar laths, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 420-425 Clay, as 415-420 above.
- 425-430 Clay, as 415-420 above, occasional ferruginous shale plate fragment.
- 430-435 Clay, as 415-420 above.
- 435-440 Clay, medium brown, occasional dark grey quartzite fragments, finely to medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 440-445 Clay, as 415-420 above.
- 445-450 Clay, as 425-430 above.
- 450-455 Clay, as 425-430 above.
- 455-460 Clay, as 425-430 above.
- 465-470 Clay, as 425-430 above.
- 470-475 Pebble Gravel, white, pink, light brown, pebbles of to 1/2" in diameter, sub-angular to sub-rounded, poorly sorted, quartz and quartzite, set in scattered medium brown and mottled white orange clay.
