## STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

- 325-330 Silty Sand, clear, light brown, rare yellow, finely grained, sub-angular, medium sorted, quartz, extremely dirty common light brown and rare orange silty and clayey interstitial material, rare to scattered carbonaceous mud and wood fragments, scattered ferruginous nodules, and orange-brown sideritic material, loosely to moderately compacted.
- 330-335 Sandy Silt, medium to dark grey, scattered yellow and yellowish brown silt lenses, rare white clay inclusions, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered brown quartz? aggregates, scattered ferruginous and sideritic clay pebble inclusions, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 335-340 Clay, medium grey, rare orange specks and patches, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, scattered light brown, slightly silty, medium to coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 340-345 Clay, as 335-340 above, scattered orange silt lenses, minor very coarsely grained quartz.
- 345-350 Clay, as 340-345 above.
- 350-355 Clay, as 340-345 above.
- 355-360 Clay, as 340-345 above.
- 360-365 Clay, as 340-345 above.
- 365-370 Clay, medium to light grey, medium to dark reddish brown, scattered yellow and orange inclusions, scattered dark brown, rounded, ferruginous clay nodules, medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 370-375 Clayey Sand, medium grey, rare white, common sandy lenses, scattered orange brown and rare black clay grains and occasional very coarse grained quartz set in clay matrix, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 375-380 Sandy Clay, medium grey, scattered white, orange and yellow scattered lenses of silt, clear, fine to coarse quartz grains, scattered orange-brown quartz clusters, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 380-385 Sandy Silt, medium grey, scattered white stringers, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, occasional very coarsely grained to small pebbles of sub-rounded quartz, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 385-390 Sandy Silt, as 380-385 above.
- 390-395 Sandy Silt, as 380-385 above.

- 400-405 Sandy Silt, as 380-385 above.

- 415-420 Clay, medium greyish-brown, scattered white silty clay stringers, rare orange brown silt patches and inclusions, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments and bright coal, scattered coarsely grained brown quartz, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
