STRATIGRAPHIC DESCRIPTION

- 410-415 Silt, light grey, very rare white and orange small patches, occasionally pebbles of sub-rounded quartz up to 1/16" diameter. medium textured, moderately compacted.
- 415-420 Silt as 410-415 above, scattered orange finely grained sand, scattered to rare carbonaceous wood fragments.
- 420-425 Clay, as 400-405 and silt as 410-415 above.
- 425-430 Clay, and Silt as 420-425 above, scattered orange-brown and reddish-brown clay pebbles, common clear and light brown, sub-rounded, very coarsely grained to pebbles of quartz up to 1/16" diameter.
- 430-435 Clay, and Silt, as 425-430 above
- 435-440 Silt, light brown, scattered yellow, white, scattered stringers of light grey clay, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, occasional pebbles of clear sub-angular to sub-rounded quartz, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 440-445 Clayey Silt, light grey, scattered orange, yellow and brown patches, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments, common clay matrix, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 445-450 Silty Sand, clear, light brown, minor yellow, finely to coarsely grained, sub-angular, poorly sorted quartz, extremely dirty, common light brown and orange silty interstitial materials, scattered white and dark brown clay fragments, scattered carbonaceous wood fragments and patches of carbonaceous matter.
- 450-455 Sandy Silt, light orange-brown, scattered coarse grains of quartz, scattered patches of carbonaceous matter and wood fragments, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.
- 455-460 Sandy Silt, as 450-455 above.
- 460-465 Sandy Silt, as 450-455 above, rare rounded white clay pebbles.
- 465-470 Silt, as 450-455 above.
