Recovered 9'0"

2'0" Clay, mottled light bluish grey and reddish brown, loosely compacted, broken into poker chips in places, scattered dark chocolate brown clay stringers

1'0" Clay, reddish brown as above, only rare to scattered light blue clay.

4'6" Clay, light to medium brown, scattered to rare light blue grey lenses of clay, loosely compacted, broken into poker chips, scattered dark brown clay along fracture plane.

0'9" Clay, reddish brown (rusty) and light blue grey mottled, as above, grades into

0'6" Clay, light blue grey as above.

0'3" Clay, rusty brown as above.

6'6" Clay, light bluish grey, massive, compacted, breaking into irregular pieces due to drying and shrinkage, scattered lenses and pipes of clear and white finely grained, well sorted, sub-rounded quartz grains having a scattered white silty interstitial material, rare (less than 1%) finely divided carbonaceous specks.

Dolerite, dark grey.

0'9" Clay, mottled orange, minor light grey, scattered carbonaceous blebs, coarsely textured, moderately compacted.

2'3" Dolerite, as above.

Recovered 3'0"

3'0" Basalt, black, common indurated sediment inclusions. Sample taken.

BORE No.60

Core No.1 (broken pieces at bottom of box)

215' Dolerite. Sample taken.
