0'9" Clay, dark chocolate brown, well compacted, breaks into poker chips, sudden break to

1'6" Clay, light blue grey, silty towards the top but becoming less so towards the base, scattered (2%) inclusions of carbonaceous wood fragments up to 1 inch in length, sudden change to

0'6" Clayey silt, mottled grey blue and rusty brown, rare mica, rare to scattered fine grains of sub-angular and angular quartz.

0'6" Clay, breccia and conglomerate, light to dark brown, orange and blue grey angular fragments and sub-rounded to rounded pebbles of ironstone, loosely compacted, set in brown clay matrix, sudden change to

0'3" Carbonaceous shale, dark grey to black, poorly bedded, common carbonaceous wood fragments and blebs.
