

Production records are rather incomplete:

1911?-1925: 1,000 tons of "ore" of unknown grade were extracted (Reid, 1926).

1925-1935: In 1927 a flotation plant was constructed by Comet Tribute Prospecting Syndicate. A record shows that in that year, the "ore" material extracted from Adit No. 3 yielded

Pb	121 tons
Zn	378 tons
Ag	10,806 oz

1935-1937: The Griffith Tribute party produced in two years about 19 tons of ore which yielded

Pb	11 tons
Ag	868 oz

1937-1948?: Texco Montana Silver-lead Dev. Co. produced 350 tons of unknown grade.

1948-1950: Lead and Nickel Mining Co. produced from about 27 tons of concentrate

Pb	22 tons
Ag	1664 oz

I Gregory (1959) estimates that the maximum production of the mine to date should be about 3,400 tons of material of unknown grade.
