Minor stoping operations were carried out above the level of the adit over a maximum vertical distance of 40 feet (refer Drg.

Adit No. 2 (1,246' A.S.L.)

Adit No. 2 is 40 feet long and exposes very minor mineralisation. No stoping was carried out.

Adit No. 3 (1,337' A.S.L.)

Lode A1 was intersected at 110 feet from the portal and followed for 240 feet. A section of the lode, 220 feet long, was stoped over a maximum vertical distance of 50 feet above the level of the adit (Stope No. 7). At 320 feet from the portal a crosscut in a south-westerly direction exposed Lode A2 and Lode A3. Lode A3 was followed, and probably stoped, over a length of 280 feet and a vertical distance of less than 40 feet (Stope No. 8). Lodes A2 and A3 were intersected also in No. 3 and No. 4 West Crosscuts but minor drifting along the strike of the lodes was undertaken. (Refer to Drg. No. B.162).

Adit No. 4 (1,474' A.S.L.)

Adit No. 4 was driven for 140 feet on to Lode A3 but no stoping was carried out.

Adits No. 5, No. 6 and No. 7

These adits are short and partly inaccessible at the present time. They were driven from the Adelaide mine creek in a northerly direction. No stoping was carried out.
