

CONCLUSIONS

Summarising, the estimated tonnages of material which, on the basis of Texins Development's exploration target limits, can be considered of "ore grade" are as follows:

Out of these, only Lens No. 5 has an average grade above 10% Zn.

The total estimated tonnage is far below the minimum limit of 2,000,000 tons set by Texins Development Pty. Ltd. in January, 1973. Further, it seems improbable, knowing the habit of the mineralisation within the tested sections of the Kosminsky-South Comet fracture zone, that such a tonnage could be found in the still untested Climie and Mariposa sections.

Our conclusions are, therefore, that the results obtained to date do not warrant any further work in the prospect area.
