1. SUMMARY:

During 1974-75, exploration for replacement type orezones of Devonian age in the Mt. Lindsay area progressed satisfactorily by way of detailed soil sampling and ground geophysical surveys.

This work has succeeded in defining a number of targets which justify diamond drilling.

A program of 6 - 7 drill holes is recommended for the 1975-76 summer in order to test these targets.

\$151,171 were spent in the area during the year, bringing total expenditure since October 1972 to \$316,860.

A total budget of \$120,000 is proposed for the 1975-76 year.

2. INTRODUCTION:

By the end of the 1973-74 year, ground and airborne geophysical surveys combined with very limited geochemical soil sampling and mapping programs had succeeded in defining two broad anomalous areas within E.L.'s 2/63 and 18/73 which justified detailed exploration, viz. the Misty Valley and Mt. Lindsay Grid Areas.
