

8. MOUNT BISCHOFF

20 square kilometres of Exploration Licence 5/63 part 1, centred on Mount Bischoff, was farmed out to Metals Exploration Limited. They have completed four diamond drill holes to explore the strike and down dip extensions of the porphyry. A fifth borehole, which is in progress, is testing the possibility of the repetition of the mineralised dolomite horizon. An airborne magnetic survey is planned.

9. ASSESSMENT OF THE COMSTAFF TENEMENTS

A.P. Bravo and D.B. Orr have examined the work which has been completed in the Comstaff tenements. This work re-emphasises the prospectivity of the areas held under Exploration Licences 1/68 and 5/63. A number of geophysical and geochemical anomalies require explanation, and the re-interpretation of the geology has highlighted areas which are geologically favourable environments for massive sulphide deposits with both hydrothermal and volcanogenic origins. A report on this assessment has been completed.
