

KR1483: moderately chloritised sericitised and
weakly cleaved, fine grained andesite

Field note: dark green fine grained, intermediate ?intrusive

This is a homogeneous, massive very fine grained igneous rock, with a very vague ? primary flow texture, superimposed and dominated by a cleavage, outlined by wavy sericitic and chloritic foliae through the groundmass.

Abundant, more or less euhedral laths of plagioclase (30-35%) are evenly scattered with very vague similar orientation. They occur in an extremely fine crystalline groundmass of plagioclase, chlorite and minor sericite, with ubiquitous ultra fine Fe and/or Ti grains.

Several quartz stringers with sericitic and chloritic margins are present.
