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of the Boco Grid lines (Bulgobac Joint Venture) which penetrated the northern boundary of the area.

Activity by Cominco Exploration is covered by the following reports:

1. Progress Report EL 11/74, Farm Creek, Tasmania for 6 months ending July, 1975.
2. Final Report EL 11/74, Farm Creek, Tullah, Tasmania 30th April, 1977.

Copies of these reports are held in Rosebery.

Cominco completed geological mapping of roads, tracks and accessible streams and collected stream sediment samples. No significant stream sediment anomalies were located. Geological mapping was supported by petrological examination of numerous specimens. Petrological examination of the same specimens by two different petrologists has in many cases produced totally different rock names indicating the petrological problems existing in the Mt. Read Volcanics. Cominco engaged contractors to fly the "HEM 400" EM system over the Farm Creek area but apparently, as no anomalies were located, the data was never plotted. A single short line of dipole-dipole I.P. was completed NW of where the Murchison Highway crosses Tramway Creek. No pseudo-section of this line has been obtained. Cominco then surrendered the licence.

7.3.2. Access

Access into the area is reasonable with the Murchison Highway and the H.E.C. access tracks to the Mackintosh Dam site passing through the area. It is noted that a Scenic Reserve exists along the Murchison Highway within the Farm Creek area.

7.3.3. Gridding (Refer Appendix XI)

Three E-W grid lines totalling 9.72km at 1km N-S spacing, were cut on the following AMG grid northings:- 5,381,500mN,
