c) Murchison Highway Track

A 1.7km long track running NNE from the Murchison Highway was cut to enable access to line 5,375,000mN at 382,860mE.

d) East From 65R Site

This track was cut up the western side of the ridge forming the northern slopes of Mt. Black and joined the logging track running down the ridge. This track was abandoned when bulldozer access was subsequently gained along the same route.

e) Mt. Black Logging Track

This track was cut over a north-south distance of 2.4km and subsequently bulldozed out for 2.0kms.

f) 5,374,000N Access Track

0.7km of track was cut up a small creek to the western end of line 5,374,000N.

2. Bulldozed Access Tracksa) D.D.H. 65R Site

The pre-existing vehicle access track to this drill site at 5,376,050mN 379,710mE was reopened. In addition to clearing regrowth, this involved blasting a new cutting on a short section where a rock slip and erosion had narrowed the track.

b) East From 65R Site

Bulldozing was successful in establishing a vehicle track from 65R Site to the logging track running down the northern slopes of Mt. Black.

c) Mt. Black Logging Track

This track was bulldozed northwards to 5,377,650mN and south to 375,680mN
