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movements along strike faults rather than due to any large regional compressional forces. Fold axes have a NNE strike, with gentle northerly plunges being predominant. Large scale open folding was recognized in the Mt. Read Volcanics north of Rosebery. Two large anticlinal ridges were recognized on the photographs trending north from Chester, and also in the Que River Volcanics north of Tullah. A broad syncline was noted north of Burns Peak, and a synform along Farm Creek (AR 2/008).

Many small scale folds were recognized on the aerial photographs.
