

6.8. Natone

It is recommended that the present Colebrook Hill Grid be extended southwards. Lines should be cut 200m apart between 5,371,000N and 5,370,000N, and 1000m apart between 5,369,500N and 5,359,500N. The lines should be geologically mapped, soil sampled, and covered with proton precession ground magnetics. The grid lines should also be used to access creeks in the area for stream sediment sampling. An attempt should be made to locate as many of the old workings in the area as possible and investigate styles of mineralisation.

On the Colebrook Hill Grid the old workings should be sampled in detail to define the Sn content of the mineralisation. Construction of access and diamond drill pads will be undertaken but may prove difficult in the very steep terrain.
