

Four exploratory diamond drill holes were put down about 100 metres to the south-west of the main dolomite horizon to test for mineralization in "buried" dolomite.

2. TENEMENTS

Exploration Licence 13/79, covering 20 square kilometers, was maintained, and regular 6 monthly re-applications for the area were submitted to the Tasmanian Department of Mines.

An application was made for an Authority to Prospect over the Fook's Lode area, SR 1965 No. 178, which was exempt from the Mining Act. Approval was given for an Authority to Prospect AP 5/80 covering 129.5 hectares over Fook's Lode commencing on 23rd June, 1980. The authority was issued subject to similar conditions which exist for Exploration Licences.

3. SURVEYING

A further 22 semi-permanent stations were established within the Mt. Bischoff grid area using a Wild T16 Theodolite. This brings the total of survey stations to 104. However, due to an accident to the vertical circle of the theodolite during the programme, stations 90 to 104 may not be accurate, especially in elevation.
