

Brown Face

As a result of the surface rubble covering the Dolomite Sulphide Lode at the eastern end of Brown Face (Desert Face end), this rubble was penetrated by taking hand auger samples. Samples were taken every 5 metres along 4 lines. No samples were taken between 2155N and 2180N on line 1300E because the depth of rubble was too deep to penetrate a diamond drill pad that had been constructed. Assay results varied between 12 ppm Sn and 0.32% Sn. The averages for each line were:
