

6. "OLD" CORE

Reboxing and re-logging of 3669.5 metres of old core was accomplished between November, 1979 and June, 1980. Thirty old diamond drill holes were selected for re-logging. All these holes passed through the main dolomite horizon. As well as the geological logging, core recoveries were recorded for all the holes.

The following holes were re-logged:

B1 to B7  
B9, B10  
B12 to B14  
B17  
B20 to B27  
B32, B33  
B44  
B47  
AAB1 to AAB5

The re-logging programme has standardized all the drilling information in the main dolomite horizon, and conforms with the recent drilling. The broad intercepts of the new logging are generally the same as in the old drill logs, and considerably more detail of the lode horizon is now known. One difference in interpretation is in hole B21: the intersection between 118.9 and 125.1, which was previously logged as a vein, has been re-interpreted as dolomite sulphide lode.
