

Expenditure

Expenditure on the tenement during the period 1.7.80 to 31.10.80 has been \$2,302. However, the account has been credited with \$5,525, representing an over accrual of the costs of the Dighem contract during the first half of 1980. Estimated expenditure during November and December is \$1,467, thus bringing the six monthly total to an estimated \$1,756 credit and the annual total to an estimated \$76,083.

Proposed Programme (Plan TAS 2-2310)

Target Sn (Cu Pb Zn)

1. Commence the establishment of access tracks into the more remote Dighem anomalies.
2. Follow up and investigate the source of Dighem anomaly 57A. This will involve the establishment of a grid and will include geological mapping, geochemical sampling and geophysical surveying.
3. Follow up and investigate the source of Dighem anomaly 44A. This will involve the establishment of a grid and will include geological mapping, geochemical sampling and geophysical surveying.
4. Follow up and investigate the source of Dighem anomalies 21G and 18C. If the sources are found to be within EL 1/68 follow up grids will be established. A programme of geological mapping, geochemical sampling and geophysical surveying will then be carried out. In any event regional geological mapping will be carried out in the area.
5. Follow up and investigate the source of Dighem anomaly 5A. This will involve the establishment of a grid and will include geological mapping, geochemical sampling and geophysical surveying.
