5	Highclere	Not positioned.
6	Buckby	Not positioned. Ground data available and report noted.
7.	Redwater*	In valley and no obvious topographic relationship. K'-850 and therefore high. Magnetite skarn. At a granite contact. Suggest near surface.
8.	Peak Hill*	Source buried about 60 m. Looks like wide source - <u>needs ground mag check</u> . K' is moderate @ 400. Cannot be basalt hill @ 1500 cgs. Needs susceptibility check. Cambrian volcanics to the south. Perhaps source is in volcanics.
9	Laurel Creek*	Fairly high amplitude for depth. 3D body and depths incorrect. Suggest K' is high. Anomaly in a valley on NE fault zone. K channel locally low but anomaly occurs in granitic environment.
10	Laurel Creek*	Anomaly source close to surface on local hill. K' is high 700-800. On granite contact and NE fault zone. Looks good.
