TASMANIAN AEROMAGNETIC & RADIOMETRIC SURVEY  
PROGRESS REPORT IV - BLOCK NO. 3

1.0 Introduction. We have examined the analogue records for the flights covering Block 3, as set out on the one-inch to one-mile aeromagnetic transparency. The report has been set out on a sheet-by-sheet basis similar to the previous reports.

In the course of examining this block we have examined the records of sheets 4340, 4339, 4239, 4240.

The anomaly numbering system has been altered, however, to give a simple sequential number to the anomalies within the sheet in question. The anomaly number which now appears is as follows:

I, JJJ, KKKK.

I = sequential number for sheet XXXX.

JJJ = line number.

KKKK = fiducial number.

Anomalies can be referred to as anomaly I on sheet XXXX. JJJ, KKKK is retained in text so that there can be no confusion with an anomaly on another sheet.
