<u>Anomaly No.</u>	<u>Comments</u>
1, 613.9687 LIEWA SOUTH.	This magnetic anomaly, although fairly weak, is difficult to explain in the geological setting. An explanation is required.
2, 613.9695 LIEWA.	We understand ground follow-up suggests only weakly magnetic material, dolerite. We suggest a highly magnetic source and, very likely, narrow. <u>Follow-up is definitely required.</u>
3, 605.9280	Possibly a deeper source, no obvious topography. The anomaly has some linearity. Moderate susceptibility, but too high for 1500 cgs. basalt.
4, 605.9276	See plans. Almost certainly a plug of magnetic rock. Perhaps related to anomaly 2?
5, 591.8610	We believe this could also be a mafic plug.
