The elongate form of the anomalies is clearly due to the sampling interval of 200x25m. There is plenty of 'room' for a massive sulphide occurrence to exist within this spacing. It has been shown at Voyager 19 that, due to the lack of a geochemical dispersion halo, a soil sample spacing of 50x12.5m is barely adequate for anomaly definition. (see 3.3 iv.)

Further infill sampling in this area and probable extensions to the south will be required.

iv) Geophysics

A Gradient Array induced polarization survey of the Voyager 29 grid was completed late in the 1981 season, the results are presented in plans 58-60.
