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The geophysics has closed off the southern anomaly. Computer modelling by Bishop (September, 1981) has suggested that the source of the northerly anomaly may be quite shallow. Neither anomaly shows chargeability values above 35mv/v. When compared with chargeabilities recorded elsewhere (e.g. Sweeneys >50mv/v), the 1700W anomalies appear to be of minor importance. However, the anomalies remain unexplained and further work may be considered if drilling of more promising anomalies of similar style, such as Anomaly 2 on the Agnew Grid, proves positive.
