

10. RECOMMENDATIONS

10.1. Agnew Grid

a) Anomaly 1 - Access;

Cutting of drillpads and helipads

- Geology;

A bedrock sampling program should ultimately be carried out to outline the surface extent of the mineralisation and to permit understanding of the differences between the geochemical and geophysical responses over the area

- Drilling;

should be designed to prove lateral and depth extensions of mineralisation to the north and west. Detailed proposals could not be made because the geophysical reports were not available at the time of writing. Evaluation of the data is essential before proposals are made. Drilling should involve two to three holes totalling 350 metres.

b) Anomaly 2 - Drilling;

one to two diamond drillholes totalling 250m are proposed assuming that an option agreement is made regarding ML 90m/72. (see section 3.2).

c) Anomaly 4 - Access;

Cutting of drillpads and helipads. It is also recommended that all lines covering this anomaly be surveyed to facilitate accurate planning of drilling.
