The trenching provided useful geological and geochemical information which was nevertheless somewhat limited by the effect of strong leaching/weathering in the upper few centimetres of bedrock beyond which the backhoe could not penetrate. It is considered that Jacro-auger sampling, where available, would give a more reliable indication of metal values than the rock chip sampling.

However, significant base metal responses were obtained from trenches on the following lines:

- 14200N (V33)
- 11400N (9421-9429E) (V29W)
- 8000N (9100-9200E) (V30)

These areas have been subjects of (or one earmarked for) more detailed investigations and the specific details are discussed under the appropriate headings (5.2, 5.4 and 5.6).
