

Anomalous areas outlined in 1984 limited to a broad Pb-80# stream anomaly with maximum values 270 ppm, draining eastern slopes of Mt. Huxley, an area of Mt. Read volcanics and Owen Conglomerate. In field traversing no indication of the source or style of mineralization was located. The only gold value from rock and stream sampling above detection limit was 0.04 ppm at east Huxley, the southern limit of Komyskans 1982 sampling. This area contains several old prospects reported by Twelvetrees 1900, none of which have been recently located or sampled.

At West Huxley only two days field work was expended investigating anomalous gold stream anomalies; the only result of this being that previous sampling should be treated with caution, sample sites poorly selected and often misplotted.
