

field were only 25 m apart, but on plan 100 m spread, e.g. 21303-05 values 0.08-0.13 gm Au, these sites close together are effectively sampling the same stream detritus, which is probably derived from the Mt. Ellen area.

Huxley saddle elevated levels in gold -80# sampling by Komysan 1982 with maximum 0.36 ppm are located in headwaters of the Toft River. From this season's sampling, the zone is cut off to the south, only sample above detection 0.04 ppm. Further north the anomaly is open, coinciding with the area containing the Lady Havill prospect and the southern end of the Huxley base metal zone. Mt. Lyell soil surveys in 1972 detected scattered anomalous base metals and minor pyrite hematite chlorite mineralization in a single prospect pit, the more extensive workings weren't located.
