

age in southern Tasmania. This aspect is in reality a reflection of the dearth of thorough exploration in this portion of the state's geology.

Limitations of the program include the lack of detailed calibration of wireline logs with rock types within the actual area of investigation, the spacing of the drill holes, and the nature of the drilling. However circumstantial evidence, both from within the area of study, and outside where the geophysical responses of coal in very similar (if not identical) sedimentary successions was known, enabled approximate calibration of the coal seams discovered during the program.

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
