

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

A total of 360 km of survey was flown in January 1984, over a property held by Amax Australia Ltd. near Sheffield, Tasmania.

The survey outlined a few weak bedrock conductors associated with areas of low resistivity. These anomalies may warrant further investigation using appropriate surface exploration techniques. The resistivity map may also yield target areas for exploration when the maps are compared to known geological and/or geochemical information. Due to the numerous cultural features in the survey area, any interpreted bedrock conductors, which occur close to cultural sources, should be confirmed as bedrock conductors prior to drilling.
