the massive felsic lava sequence of central White Spur is quite sharply outlined (See discussion, Section 9.4.4.). A major aeromagnetic anomaly has been outlined in the hanging wall of the Rosebery deposit and continues along strike for at least 2km towards the old Cutty Sark workings. Modelling of this magnetic anomaly gave a depth to source of 250m in the vicinity of EZ Company DDH 71R. The probable source of this anomaly is two lenses of massive magnetite intersected 240m below the surface in the drill hole. The magnetite carries minor base metal and silver mineralization, but no significant gold values.

3.4. Conclusions and Recommendations

The DIGHEM survey has highlighted several areas of interest within the Rosebery East area that warrant more detailed investigation. The results have indicated considerable untested exploration potential remains, specifically in the Murchison River, Mt. Black, Stitt Valley and White Spur areas. Recommended programs for these areas are included in the reports for these specific areas.

Further detailed examination of the DIGHEM report is expected to lead to recommendations for follow-up work in other areas.
