

because of alluvial cover mapped by EZ Company, but the area lies immediately adjacent to the massive sulphide clasts.

The other remaining exploration potential of the area appears to lie with the largely untested gold mineralization associated with the Cutty Sark workings.

It is recommended that an evaluation of this gold potential at Cutty Sark, be conducted. Initially, detailed and comprehensive rock geochemistry and lithological (petrographic) studies should be completed. All previous exploration data should be assessed and, if necessary, additional geophysical and/or geochemical surveys conducted. If the results of this investigation are encouraging, drill testing of the area is proposed. Such drilling could be designed to simultaneously test the IP anomaly and possible soil geochemical anomaly extension beneath Lake Rosebery, near line 13,500N, 600m north of DDH CS1.
