

INTRODUCTION

Colebrook Hill is only a few kilometres west of the Rosebery Mine in Tasmania.

Investigations for mineralisation have taken place over a number of years to find extensions, or perhaps the main lode, in the area around co-ordinates 5,371,500N, 375,000E.

Almost all the geophysical surveys have given highly anomalous results, but over such a large area as to make the siting of drillholes to test for massive mineralisation rather difficult. The data used for this report is as follows:
