

indication of its total off-hole width. Subsequent drilling should have a similar loop layout for down hole Sirotem logs. Other arrangements are possible, but in this environment simplicity is probably an advantage. The array described has a 200m loop to the west of the drill-collar and another to the east, with the drill hole being at the centre of the N-S common line.

Similar loop arrangements are recommended for down hole Sirotem logs of CHP 241 and CHP 243. In both cases two 200m x 200m loops laid firstly eastwards, and secondly westwards of the drill collar, with the drill-collar being central in the north-south common line. A common loop for both drill holes was considered, but will probably not provide such clear information as two separate loops.



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
