The map shows the distribution of various rock types and alteration zones. The boundaries between these units are shown as solid lines for definite boundaries, dashed lines for approximate boundaries, and dotted lines for inferred boundaries. The map also shows the locations of various structures and lineaments. The scale of the map is 1:500 metres. The north arrow indicates the direction of true north.
