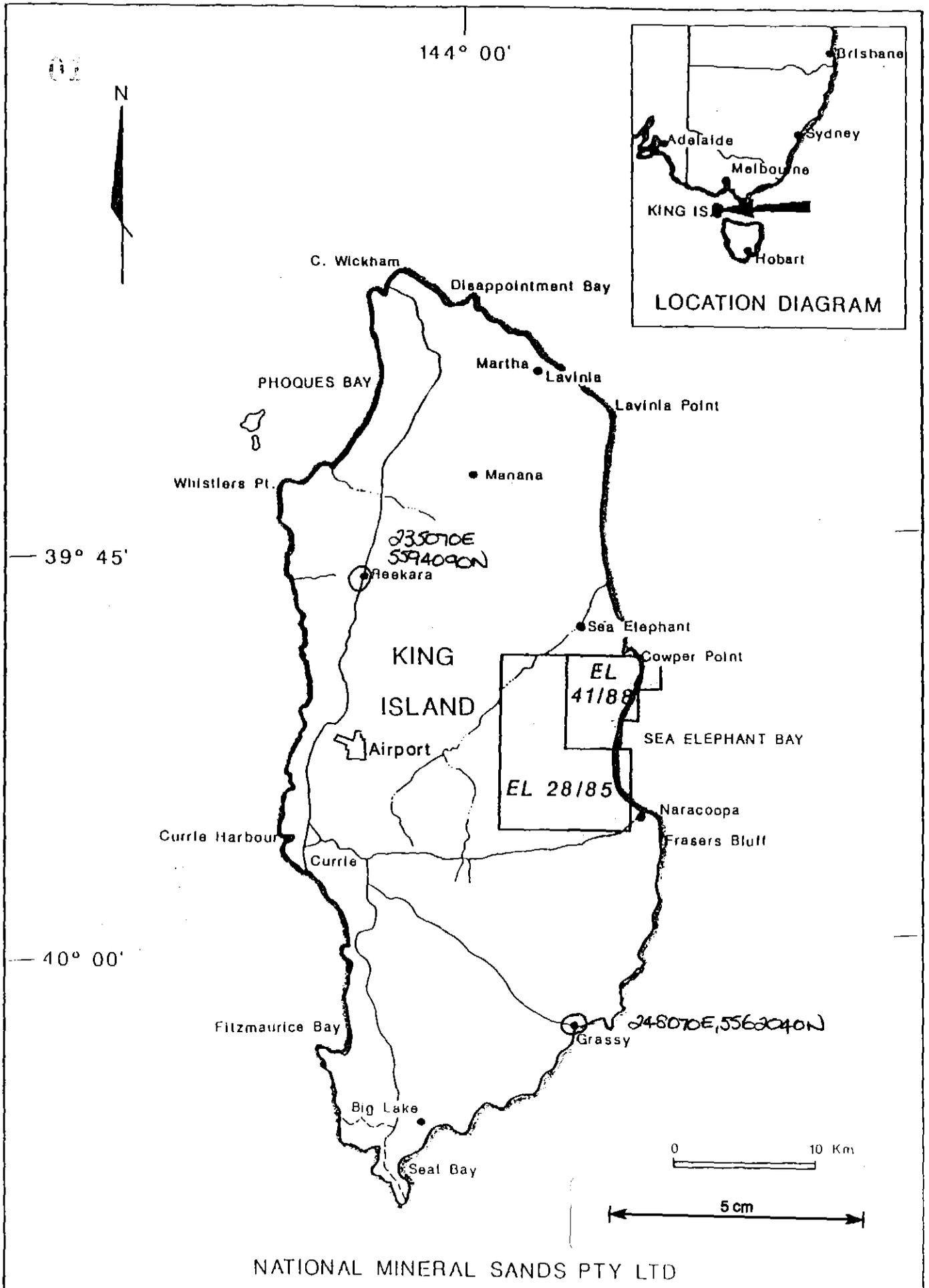

1. Tenement Information

EL 41/88 occupies an area of 30 square km on the east coast of King Island near Cowper Point at the north end of Sea Elephant Bay. It was granted on 28 October, 1988, and is immediately adjacent to EL 28/85 also held by the Licensees.

2. Previous Exploration

The Naracoopa/Cowper Point area has been the target of a major exploration and project evaluation study, culminating in a Feasibility Study completed in August, 1989, and based on heavy mineral sands resources on EL 41/88 and EL 28/85.

Four deposits were identified, including two (Cowper Point East and Cowper Point West) on EL 41/88.

Total probable reserves over the two exploration licence areas were estimated at 16.8mt Sand, containing 1 013 000t Heavy Minerals, including 60 500t Rutile and 75 000 t Zircon. Of this total reserve, the two deposits on EL 41/88 comprise 11.5mt Sand containing 503 000t Heavy Minerals, including 32 000 Rutile, and 43 000t Zircon.

Further details of the reserve estimates are provided in the attached tabulation.

Metallurgical testwork confirmed that marketable grades of Rutile and Zircon products could be produced, but that significant quantities of Ilmenite contained in the resource were not marketable due to high levels of included chromium.

3. Work Completed During Report Period

The Feasibility Study was subject to intensive review and re-evaluation during the year culminating in the purchase of National Mineral Sands Pty. Ltd., by Peko Wallsend Operations Ltd., and a decision by the latter company to prepare applications and seek mining licences over the four deposits.

Discussions with the Department of Mines have resulted in a plan for marking out, involving 15 lease applications. Current owners of land in the proposed applications areas have been largely identified, and a draft compensation agreement prepared.

Criteria and scope for a Development Proposal and a draft Environment Management Plan have been prepared.

During the later part of the period a Consultant was retained to investigate and advise on a programme for obtaining the statutory and community approvals for the Naracoopa Mineral Sands Project including the securing of mining leases. Initial indications are that support for project development will be obtained from the relevant statutory authorities regarding leases, environment, roads, port facilities and export permits. Further planning is in progress with a view to implementing this programme.

4. Future Work

Activities will be concerned with:-

- . marking out and submission of Mining Lease Applications
- . negotiations with landowners
- . finalisation and submission of the Development Proposal and draft EMP
- . preparation and submission of Planning Permit Applications

Site activities will be limited to marking out the areas for the Mining Lease Applications.
