The comments of Brown, Potter (1981) remain applicable, but the information is still not in a form, or of sufficient accuracy to be reliably used.

All geographical information on all underground diamond drill holes is now stored on disc using the HP 9825 computer on site. The programme is not yet complete and needs further refining. With the addition of the digitizer to the unit it is now possible to measure areas faster and more accurately than before. All ore resource area calculations are now done with this machine. The next logical step is to have a simple ore resource calculation programme.
