


- Undifferentiated Quaternary sediments
- Boulderly mudstone, sandstone & siltstone
- Quartzwacke interbedded with black phylitic mudstone, grey siltstone & minor conglomerate. Includes some units of dominantly siltstone (C0q3)
- Dominantly siltstone and sandstone with minor conglomerate.
- Felsic tuff and agglomerate, generally quartz-feldspar phytic.
- Basalt, Henty Dyke Swarm
- Mainly felsic pyroclastic rocks, dominantly feldspar phytic, including pumice bearing tuff & breccia, crystal vitric tuff, vitric tuff & minor shale & sandstone
- Flame-bearing eutaxitic tuff of ignimbrite type. Some block-&ash flow units shown (C0vb)
- Crystal tuff, crystal-lithic tuff, commonly bedded.
- Fine grained vitric tuff.
- Units of bedded siltstone, sandstone, tuff & agglomerate
- Undifferentiated massflows, sandstones & black siltstones
- Ashy siltstone
- Units of bedded siltstone, sandstone

- Dominantly greywacke & mudstone with some interbedded vitric tuff, crystal tuff & crystal-lithic tuff

- Crystal rich volcaniclastics sandstone

- Rhyolitic-dacitic massflows, commonly graded
- Quartz feldspar porphyry
