E.L. 41/96 covers an area of 16 km² in the District of Dorset in the vicinity of Burns Creek.

The country rock is mathinna beds and related alluvium.

The tenement was considered prospective for vein style gold deposits because of the existence of the "Burns Creek Gold Mine".

Several grab samples were taken from the old workings, with only one assayed (this returned a nil return for gold, gold being the only element tested for).


The prospect of an average grade of 30gms/ton/Au and 15gms/ton/Ag seems unlikely.

There are also several rumours of these old workings being "salted".

As a result of these circumstances the whole area of E.L. 41/96 is to be relinquished (see attached map).
