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1.0 SUMMARY

Exploration Licence 7/96 has been held by the partnership of Timron Mining (T. Parish & R. Gregory) and P.A. & S.A. Coffey for the purpose of exploring for mineable quantities of quartz sand in the Kamona district.

2.0 LOCATION AND ACCESS

Figure One provides a good view of the location and access to the licence which is in the Kamona district near Scottsdale.

3.0 TENEMENT INFORMATION

The licence originally covered 9 sq. km. and was reduced to 7 sq. km. in early 1999 following relinquishment of 2 sq. km.

The following tenements were excluded from the licence.

- 21M/90 T. Parish
- 41M/83 Stornaway Hewitt
- 93M/80 Island Resources
- 94M/80 Island Resources
- 15M/89 Island Resources

4.0 GEOLOGY

All exploration was carried out in tertiary sands and gravels of granitic origin

5.0 EXPLORATION 1996 TO 1999

- 1996 Field inspection on foot to locate prospective areas
- 1997/8 Pitting of the hill one kilometre north of 21M/90
- 1998/9 Pitting of the two low knolls situated about 750 metres south east of 21M/90 on Goanna Track.

6.0 RESULTS

- 1997/8 A deposit with a potential for 50,000 tonnes was located on the hill one kilometre north of 21M/90
- 1998/9 A good fine sand was located on the two low knolls to the south east of 21M90. Unfortunately insufficient reserves to support a mining operation existed and consequently the area was abandoned.

7.0 REHABILITATION

All pits were filled in immediately after sampling and then levelled to existing ground surface. Seeding will be by adjoining vegetation. No lasting damage has been done to the local environment in the opinion of the operators.
