



PROJECTION: Universal Transverse Mercator (UTM).
HORIZONTAL DATUM: Australian Geosidic Datum 1983.
VERTICAL DATUM: Australian Height Datum (Tasmanian ascending offshore islands whose datum is mean sea level).
GRID: 100 metre intervals of the Universal Transverse Mercator Grid, Zone 55 (Australian Map Grid, Australian National Spheroid Grid values are shown in full at the south west corner of the map).
CONTOUR INTERVAL: 10 metres with 50 metre index contours.
WORLD GEODETIC SYSTEM 1972: To convert co-ordinates from the system to Australian Geosidic Datum 1983, increase the value of latitude by 5.7, equivalent to 102 metres, and decrease the value of longitude by 5.47, equivalent to 100 metres. To obtain height increase satellite heights by 2 metres.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: True, Grid and Magnetic North are shown diagrammatically for the centre of the map. Magnetic North is correct for 1984 and moves westerly about 0.17 every two years.
REVISION: A five yearly revision cycle is intended for this series. Users using errors and omissions are referred to the Director of Mapping, GPO Box 464, Hobart, Tasmania, 7001.
