

PRODUCTION: Mapping Division, Lands Department, Hobart, 1985.
ACCURACY: Horizontal: 90% of grid defined detail to within 12.5 metres of true position. Vertical: 90% of elevations are within 5 metres. These accuracies may not be achieved in areas of dense vegetation.
RELIABILITY: Topography compiled from aerial photography flown 1982 with field verification 1983. Place names have been approved by the Nomenclature Board of Tasmania.
PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY: Roads on this map do not necessarily indicate a public right of way.
REVISION: A five yearly revision cycle is intended for this series. Heavy printing errors and omissions are invited to write to the Director of Mapping, GPO Box 444, Hobart, Tasmania, 7001.
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PROJECTION: Universal Transverse Mercator (UTM).
HORIZONTAL DATUM: Australian Geodesic Datum 1984.
VERTICAL DATUM: Australian Height Datum (Tasmania) excepting offshore islands whose datum is mean sea level.
GRID: 1000 metres intervals of the Universal Transverse Mercator Grid, Zone 58 Australian Map Grid. Australian National Geodetic Grid values are shown in full at the south west corner of the map.
CONTOUR INTERVAL: 10 metres with 50 metres index contours.
WORLD GEODETIC SYSTEM 1972: To convert coordinates from this system to Australian Geodesic Datum 1984, increase the value of latitude by 1.5", equivalent to 165 metres, and decrease the value of longitude by 4", equivalent to 100 metres. To obtain heights increase surface heights by 2 metres.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: True, Grid and Magnetic North are shown approximately for the centre of the map. Magnetic North is correct for 1985 and moves easterly about 0.1" every two years.
