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PROJECTION: Universal Transverse Mercator (UTM).
HORIZONTAL DATUM: Australian Geodesic Datum 1986.
VERTICAL DATUM: Australian Height Datum (Tasmania) excluding offshore islands whose datum is mean sea level.
GRID: 1000 metre intervals of the Universal Transverse Mercator Grid. Zone 58 (Australian Map Grid, Australian National Spheroid). Grid values are shown in full at the south west corner of the map.
CONTOUR INTERVAL: 10 metres with 50 metre radio contours. Contours are shown in full at the south west corner of the map.
WORLD GEODETIC SYSTEM 1972: To convert co-ordinates from this system to Australian Geodesic Datum 1986, increase the value of longitude by 4.4", equivalent to 100 metres, and decrease the value of latitude by 5.2", equivalent to 100 metres. To obtain heights decrease by 1985.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: True, Grid and Magnetic North are shown discontinuously for the centre of the map. Magnetic North is correct for 1984 and moves easterly about 0.1" every two years.
