


PRODUCTION: Mapping Division, Department of Lands, Parks and Wildlife, Hobart, 1988.
ACCURACY: Horizontal: Not less than 90% of points of well defined detail are within 12.5 metres of their true position at map scale.
VERTICAL: Not less than 90% of elevations are within 5 metres of their true elevation. This accuracy may not be achieved in areas of dense vegetation.
RELIABILITY: The information content of this map has been determined from aerial photography taken in May 1988 and verified by field inspection undertaken in Oct 1987. It contains as far as possible, information appropriate to the scale, the geographical locality, and the general purpose of this map.
NOMENCLATURE: Place names have been approved by the Nomenclature Board of Tasmania.
PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY: Roads on this map do not necessarily indicate a public right of way.
REVISIONS: A five yearly revision cycle is planned for this series. Users noting errors and omissions are invited to write to the Director of Mapping, G.P.O. Box 44A, Hobart, Tasmania, 7001.
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PROJECTION: Universal Transverse Mercator (UTM).
HORIZONTAL DATUM: Australian Geoid Datum 1985.
VERTICAL DATUM: Australian Height Datum (Tasmanian) excepting offshore islands whose datum is mean sea level.
GRID: 1000 metre intervals of the Universal Transverse Mercator Grid, Zone 52 (Australia Map Grid), Australian National Spheroid. Grid values are shown in 100 m intervals at the south west corner of the map.
CONTOUR INTERVAL: 10 metres with 50 metre index contours.
WORLD GEODETIC SYSTEM 1972: To convert co-ordinates from the system to Australian Geoid Datum 1985, increase the value of latitude by 527 equivalent to 101 metres, and decrease the value of longitude by 44' equivalent to 100 metres. To obtain heights increase summit heights by 2 metres.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: True, Grid and Magnetic North are shown diagrammatically for the centre of the map. Magnetic North is correct for 1988 and moves easterly about 0.1' every two years.

GRID ZONE DESIGNATION: 52G
100 000 METRE SQUARE IDENTIFICATION: 66110 55
To give a standard reference to the nearest 100 metres:
1. State name and number of this map.
2. Locate the VERTICAL grid line to the left of point and read large figures only in either the top or bottom margin (e.g. 66110). Estimate northings from grid line to point (e.g. 55).
3. Locate the HORIZONTAL grid line below the point and read large figures only in either the left or right margin (e.g. 55). Estimate eastings from grid line to point (e.g. 110).
To give full grid reference, prefix with Grid Zone Designation and 100 000 metre Square Identification letters (e.g. 52G0611055).
