Group Symbol (unified soil classification system): GM-SM

Geological Description: Permian - Ables Bay Formation - siltstone, sandy siltstone, minor sandstone with dropstones and occasional fossils. Some may be slope deposits of Permian rocks.

History: Huonville council used pit about 10 years ago for road works but found material unsatisfactory.

Remarks: Sample may not be representative because some large boulders (220cm dia) excluded. Sample from the more weathered portion of pit
