Group Symbol (unified soil classification system): Rev - SC.

Geological Description: Tertiary river gravels ⇒ gravel (quartz rounded pebbles) coarse → fine clayey sand.

History: Pit has been worked intermittently for about 80 years.

Remarks: Too much clay, so only used as filling when it was worked. Variable composition - hard to sample representatively. 100 x 45 x 4 = 18,000 m³.
